

**ORDINANCE NO. 28-C**  
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 28**  
**CARLTON COUNTY SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE**

The Board of County Commissioners ordains as follows:

Section I

Section 4, Subdivision C, b, 7 of Ordinance #28 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

7. Locations and provisions for individual water supply and sewage disposal for each lot that meets the requirements of Ordinance No. 30, Subsurface Sewage Treatment System Ordinance.

Section II

Section 5, Subdivision C, 2, i of Ordinance No. 28 is amended to read in its entirety to read as follows:

i. Soils maps showing soil types, rock outcrops, and other information from the Natural Resource Conservation Service. Soil test results demonstrating the adequacy of the property for the intended development in terms of ground water level, load bearing capacity and ability to meet *Ordinance No. 30, Subsurface Sewage Treatment Systems*.

Section III

Section 5, Subdivision C, 3, j of Ordinance #28 shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

j. Location and provisions for individual water supply and sewage disposal including the location of two suitable sites for ISTS for each lot that meets the requirements of *Ordinance No. 30, Subsurface Sewage Treatment Systems*.

Section IV

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on January 1, 2010 after its passage and publication according to law.
